AS level Further Mathematics

Paper 1: Further Pure Mathematics 50% 1 hour 40 mins, 80 marks	Compulsory AS further mathematics content
Paper 2: Further Mathematics Options 50% 1 hour 40 mins, 80 marks	Students take one paper (made out of two sections) with two of the following four options: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Further Pure Mathematics• Further Statistics• Further Mechanics• Decision Mathematics

A level Further Mathematics

Paper 1: Further Pure Mathematics 1 25% 1 hour 30 mins, 80 marks	Compulsory Any further pure mathematics content can be assessed on either paper
Paper 2: Further Pure Mathematics 2 25% 1 hour 30 mins, 80 marks	
Paper 3: Further Mathematics Option 1 25% 1 hour 30 mins, 80 marks	Students take two optional papers with options available in: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Further Pure Mathematics• Further Statistics• Further Mechanics• Decision Mathematics
Paper 4: Further Mathematics Option 2 25% 1 hour 30 mins, 80 marks	

AS and A level Further Mathematics options

For Paper 2 in AS and Paper 3 in A level Further Mathematics students choose a pair of options, either

- ✓ any two from column A, or
- ✓ a matching pair from columns A and B
